The Democratic Republic of the Congo is one of the largest, most populous, and most naturally resource-rich states on the African continent, but it is also characterized by internal conflict, severe political instability, and severely deficient basic services. Food insecurity and malnutrition, poverty and violence generate millions of refugees and displaced people each year.

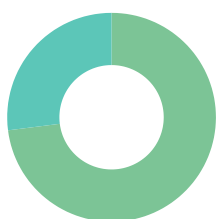
Present in the field since 1977, COOPI has a deep knowledge of the country where it has long carried out activities to protect, prevent and combat malnutrition, and promote food security.

In DRC COOPI has always paid special attention to women and children survivors of gender-based violence, forced recruitment, and other human rights violations, offering psycho-social support services and free health care, promoting prevention and protection projects, and encouraging educational and professional reintegration.

COOPI IN DRC TODAY

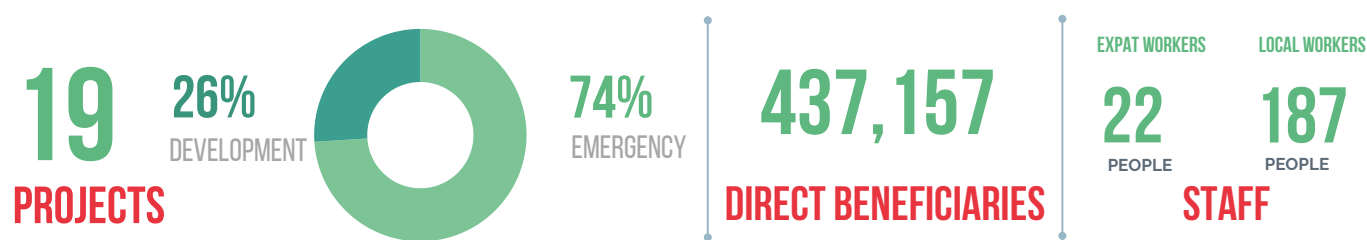
In the DRC, COOPI primarily conducts activities to **combat malnutrition** by carrying out prevention, treatment and nutritional support for thousands of malnourished children and mothers.

Another relevant area of activity is the **protection of children**, often unaccompanied minors formerly associated with armed groups, and women survivors of gender-based violence. In this area, COOPI provides thousands of children and women each year with **cross-cutting assistance** aimed at overcoming severe trauma and improving the quality of life of the victims through **psycho-physical care, socio-economic reintegration, and educational reintegration**.

Another relevant activity carried out in the country concerns the promotion of **food security** with the provision of food and seeds, training of farmers, and, more recently, the simultaneous promotion of environmental protection with sustainable natural resource management interventions in large protected areas.

In DRC COOPI also carries out activities to promote **access to water** with the rehabilitation of wells and latrines and promotes good **hygiene practices**.

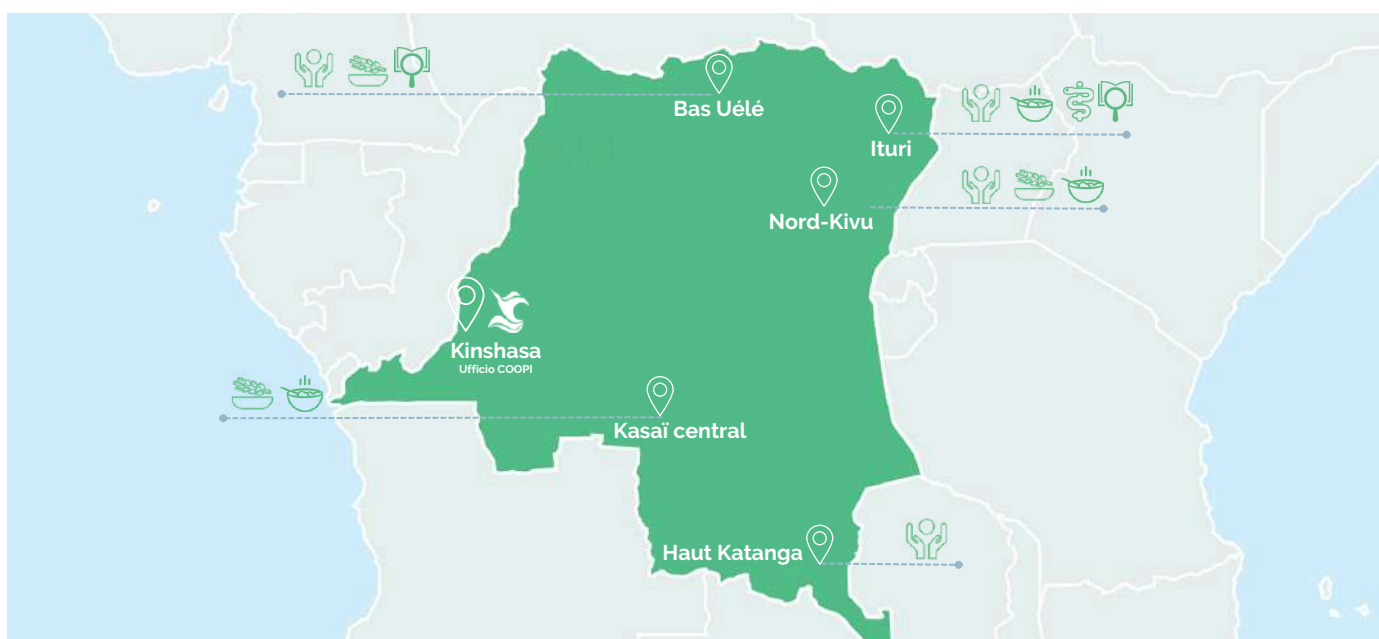
For some years now, COOPI has been implementing the first reparation project in the DRC, in the province of Ituri, which provides reparation services and other forms of assistance to former child soldiers.



SECTORS IN WHICH COOPI OPERATES IN THE COUNTRY



COOPI is currently present in the DRC in the provinces of Nord-Kivu, Upper Katanga, Central Kasai, Ituri, and Lower Uélé. COOPI's DRC office is also located in Kinshasa.



MAIN AREAS OF INTERVENTION



NUTRITIONAL SECURITY

In response to the severe malnutrition affecting the country and the urgent needs of vulnerable children and mothers, COOPI promotes nutritional security in DRC by intervening on multiple fronts:

- TAKING CARE OF CHILDREN WITH SEVERE AND MODERATE MALNUTRITION WITHIN OUTPATIENT NUTRITIONAL THERAPEUTIC UNITS;
- AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS ON GOOD PRACTICES IN BREASTFEEDING, INFANT AND YOUNG CHILD FEEDING AND FOOD DIVERSIFICATION TECHNIQUES;
- NEWBORN SCREENING FOR MALNUTRITION AND TRAINING ON BRACHIAL PERIMETER MEASUREMENT;
- ESTABLISHMENT OF SCHOOL CANTEENS AND NUTRITIONAL ASSISTANCE TO BOYS AND GIRLS REINTEGRATED INTO THE SCHOOL SYSTEM;
- COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAMS, COOKING DEMONSTRATIONS, AND INVOLVEMENT OF NUMEROUS LOCAL STAKEHOLDERS, INCLUDING HEALTH DISTRICTS IN THE INTERVENTION AREAS AND INFANT AND YOUNG CHILD FEEDING SUPPORT GROUPS.

FOOD SECURITY AND LIVELIHOODS

COOPI has been promoting Food Security in DRC since it began operations in the country in 1977. Within this framework, COOPI continuously implements integrated development programs that mainly include:

- FOOD DISTRIBUTION;
- INITIATION AND REVITALIZATION OF AGROPASTORAL ACTIVITIES;
- IMPROVEMENT OF STORAGE CAPACITIES FOR AGRICULTURAL AND LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS;
- SUPPORT FOR SMALL ENTREPRENEURS, RETURNING MIGRANTS AND YOUTH AT RISK OF MIGRATION.

MAIN AREAS OF INTERVENTION



PROTECTION

Protection activities are a constant in the programs carried out by COOPI in DRC and are present across the board in most of the interventions in the field, with a particular focus on children and women.

COOPI promotes psycho-social support interventions and free health care in the country, managing prevention and protection projects against forced recruitment of children in conflict contexts, promoting educational and professional reintegration activities, through a participatory approach and from a gender perspective.

COOPI promotes Protection activities in DRC on multiple levels:

- PROTECTION MECHANISMS FOR UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN, CHILDREN FORMERLY ASSOCIATED WITH ARMED GROUPS, VICTIMS OF GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE;
- MECHANISMS FOR IDENTIFYING, MONITORING AND REPORTING SERIOUS VIOLATIONS OF CHILDREN'S RIGHTS;
- LISTENING CENTERS AND PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSISTANCE TO CHILDREN TO ACCOMPANY THEIR DEVELOPMENT AND RESTORE THEIR SELF-ESTEEM AFTER TRAUMA;
- CREATION OF PROTECTED SPACES AND CHILD-FRIENDLY RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES;
- SOCIAL, EDUCATIONAL AND ECONOMIC REINTEGRATION ACTIVITIES FOR VICTIMS OF WAR CRIMES AND CRIMES AGAINST HUMANITY;
- AWARENESS SESSIONS ON PEACE EDUCATION, GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE AND MENTAL HEALTH;
- PROMOTION OF INCOME-GENERATING ACTIVITIES AIMED AT ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT AND EMANCIPATION OF WOMEN BENEFICIARIES.

COOPI DEVELOPMENT LINES IN DRC

COOPI's priority areas of intervention in the near future in the DRC will remain:

- **Protection** by strengthening assistance to women victims of gender-based violence, unaccompanied minors victims of abuse and the armed conflicts, while promoting awareness-raising and training activities;
- **Nutrition** through strengthening community health centers and activities to prevent and take over cases of malnutrition;
- **Food Security** mainly through strengthening the agribusiness supply chain and increasing agricultural productivity. This area of activity will be conducted in parallel with the promotion of **environmental protection** through the promotion of proper resource management in large natural parks from a **sustainable and community perspective**.
